

NCAHA POINTS Guidelines September 2011

Points:

The NCAHA points system has been implemented to facilitate reporting and nomination of exhibitors and horses to the ApHC for the World Championship Horse Show.

Year-end awards are presented to exhibitors and horses that are awarded the most points at NCAHA approved horse shows. There will be Grand and Reserve champions for any NCAHA sponsored class. Points are awarded as follows:

1 st = 8 Points	2 nd = 7 Points	3 rd = 6 Points	4 th = 5 Points
5 th = 4 Points	6 th = 3 Points	7 th = 2 Points	8 th = 1 Points

Members:

Only Current NCAHA Youth and Non-pro exhibitors in good standing are eligible to compete for year-end awards. Non-pro/Youth Points Enrollment Forms must be turned in and verified by the points-keeper prior to the accumulation of points by the exhibitor. Only members in good standing that have received NCAHA points are eligible for nomination by the NCAHA, to the ApHC World Championship Horse Show.

Horses:

Only nominated horses are eligible to compete for year-end awards. Horse owners must be NCAHA members. Points Enrollment Forms must be received and verified by the points-keeper for each horse prior to the accumulation of points by the horse. Shows attended prior to the acceptance of paperwork will not be accrued for year-end awards. Only horses that have shown and received NCAHA points are eligible for nomination to the ApHC World Championship Horse Show.

Points-keeper:

Write the date of receipt on each non-pro/youth enrollment form when they are received.

Send forms and points reports to the chairperson of the points committee upon request.

Points will be accrued for NCAHA approved shows only.

Youth and Non-Pro exhibitors must show at the NCAHA August show.

The NCAHA does not point the ApHC National or World shows.
